Money is a medium of exchange; it allows people to obtain what they need to live. Money is any object that is generally accepted as payment for goods and services and repayment of debts in a given country or social-economic context.








Symbol of rupees:







REMEMBER

* Money is in the form of coins and notes.

* In India, currency is in rupees and paise.

* Symbol of rupees is ₹ and paise is p.

* Coins are made of metals and notes are printed on paper.

B. Write the following amounts in words:

- 1. ₹ 48.40 = Forty eight rupees and forty paise.
- 2. ₹ 125.25 = One hundred twenty five rupees and twenty five paise.
- 3. ₹ 444.80 = Four hundred forty four rupees and eighty paise.
- 4. ₹ 787.05 = Seven hundred eighty seven rupees and five paise.


