* Money is in the form of coins and notes.

* In India, currency is in rupees and paise.

* Symbol of rupees is (₹) and paise is (p).

* Coins are made of metals and notes are printed on paper.

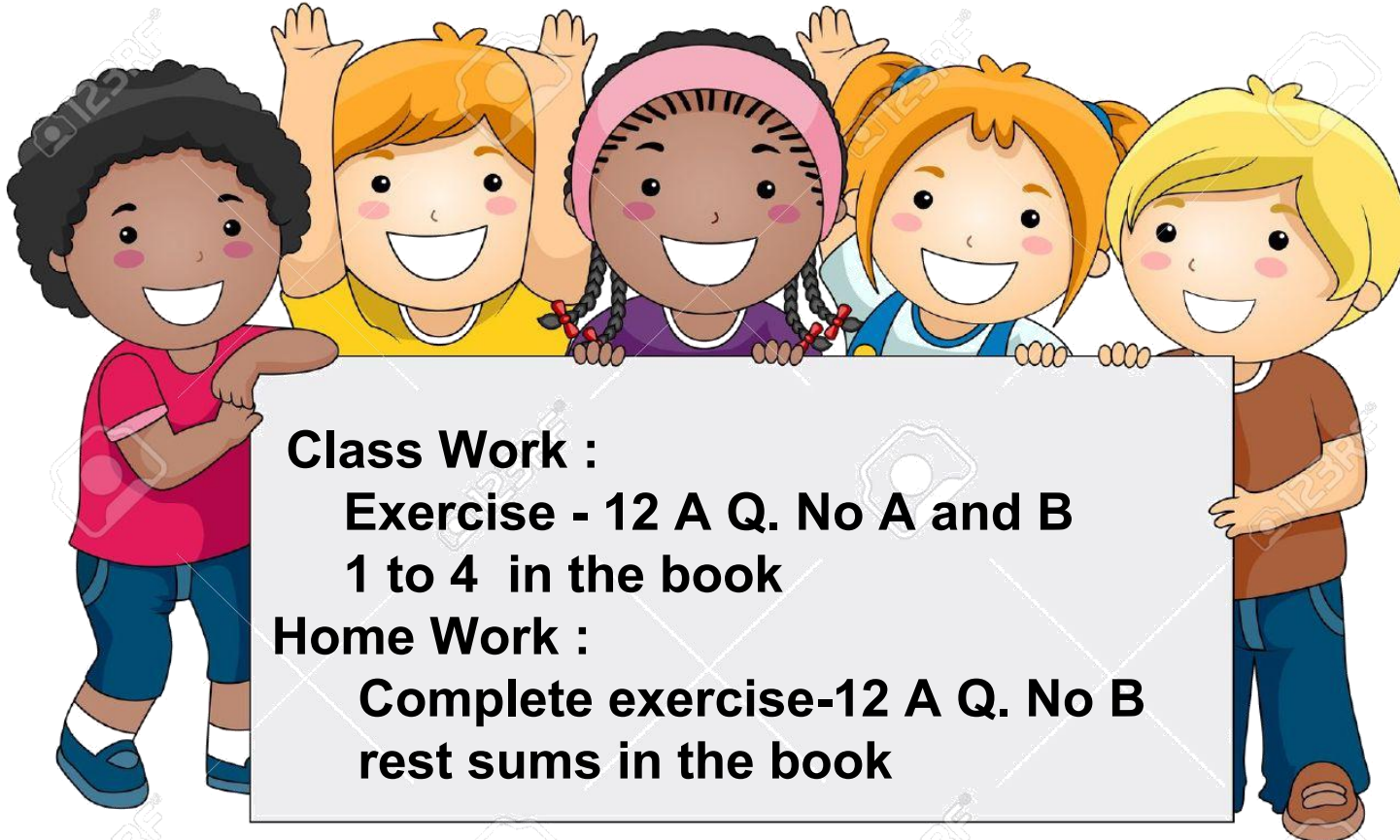
