














ASCENDING ORDER & DESCENDING ORDER

We see, 3 < 4 < 6 < 8


So, 354 < 426 < 650 < 812





ASCENDING ORDER & DESCENDING ORDER

Compare the hundred place and arrange in descending order




We see, 8 > 6 > 4 > 3


