HOW TO USE THIS BOOK

- The title of the book signifies the development of four skills for better results. The book may be used as follows. Only one letter is taught until each and every child of the class learns it.
- The children pronounce the letters after the teacher. The teacher reads aloud the words given related to different letters.
- The children are advised to develop the four skills like **Matching, Co-relating, Filling in the Blanks** and **Recognising the Letters with Pictures**.
- The children are advised to learn by doing some activities like colouring the pictures, marking the letters with thick crayons, playing with flash cards and other aids, sticking the pictures, etc.
- The activity pages are presented at small interval after every 5 letters which is meant for revision and evaluation of skills.
- Parents and teachers are advised to teach their children by **Reading, Writing, Speaking, Listening and Playing the Games**.

As the face is the index of mind, similarly concept and recognition is the reflection of an individual's personality. "**Look, Learn and Write**" is a series which helps the child at the pre-primary level to recognise and write the alphabets which is carefully designed in this book.

Activity – II: Collect an old English Newspaper, find and ring around the letters: **A, B, C, D, E** and submit it to the teacher.

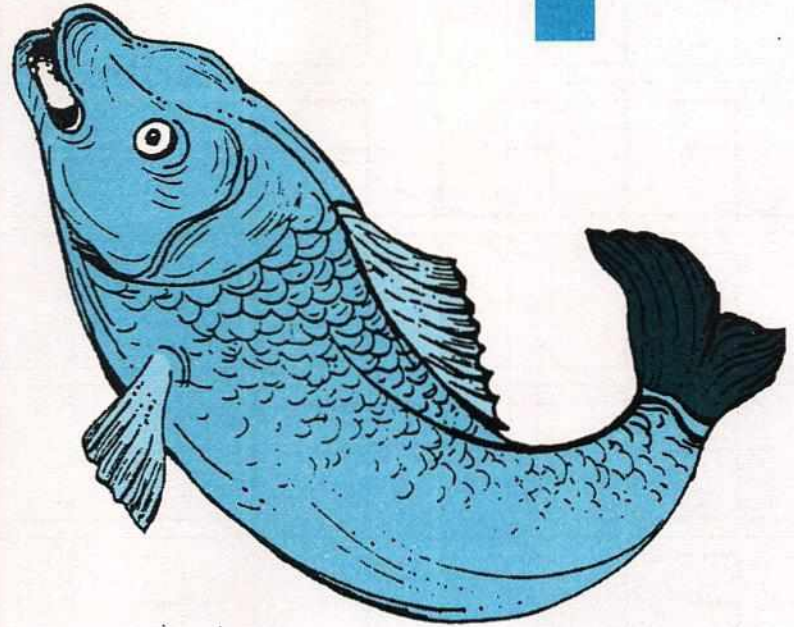

If he/she says correctly then give a star. The one who tells all correct will be the winner.

Now the leader will sing the song ‘Fairies are dancing’ call the letter **A** and the child will join with the leader as per their flash cards.
