#### FIRST COMMUNICATION SATELLITE

Telstar 1 was a communications satellite launched by NASA on July 10, 1962, it was the satellite that allowed the first live broadcast of television images between the United States and Europe.





## FIRST COMMUNICATION SATELLITE OF INDIA

- Ariane Passenger PayLoad Experiment, (APPLE) was an experimental communication satellite successfully launched by Ariane-1, from Kourou, French Guiana on June 19, 1981, exactly 35 years back, marking an important milestone in India's space programme.
- APPLE was dedicated to the Nation on August 13, 1981 by then Prime Minister Mrs.Indira Gandhi.



A geostationary satellite is an earth-orbiting satellite, placed at an altitude of approximately 35,800 kilometers directly over the equator.
