Kashmiri, Dongri, Urdu and Ladakh are the languages spoken here.




Eid and Shivaratri are the main festivals.

highest mountain peak in the world.


- The state is famous for the orchids.

- It is famous for the tea grown on the slopes of the hill.






Life in the Northern Mountains - The north-eastern states










- Arunachal Pradesh is covered by mountains.

The Manipuri dance is famous all over the country.






- Mizoram situated in the south of the region.


