Brahmaputra is the longest river between three river.




- It brings a lot of water to India.

- Then Bangladesh and makes Sundarban Delta and joins Bay of Bengal.


Life in the Northern Plains

- It is a well-planned city.






- The famous Golden

Industries such as textiles, sports, goods, hosiery and motor parts are well developed.










- The people speak Punjabi and Hindi.

- The main languages spoken here are Hindi, English, Punjabi and Urdu.







There are many monuments of historical
