WORD PROBLEM

2. There are 36 mangoes in a basket. Out of these, 15 mangoes are bad. How many good mangoes are there in the basket?

Total mangoes = 36

Number of bad mangoes = 15

Number of good mangoes = 21



Ans: There are 21 good mangoes in the basket.

4. There were 130 fish in a lake. A fisherman took away 36 of them. How many fish were left in the lake?

$$\begin{array}{r}
 \text{Total fish} = 120 \\
 \text{Number of fish taken} = 36 \\
 \hline
 \text{Number of fish left} = 094
 \end{array}$$

Ans: 94 fish were left.

6. Sapna had ₹ 980. She spent ₹ 280 to buy a doll. How much money does she have now?

Total amount of money = ₹ 980

Amount of money spent = ₹ 280

Amount of money she has = ₹ 700

Ans: Now she has ₹ 700.

8. There were 650 students in a school play ground. 56 students went into the class room. How many students are left on the ground?


