\*Multiplication is repeated addition.

\*When two numbers are multiplied, the answer is called **PRODUCT**.

\*The sign of multiplication is ' $\times$ '.



$$4 \times 3 = 12$$

Multiplicand

Product

Multiplier

The number which is being multiplied is called multiplicand.

The number by which the multiplicand is multiplied is called the multiplier.



# JUST HAVE A RECAP

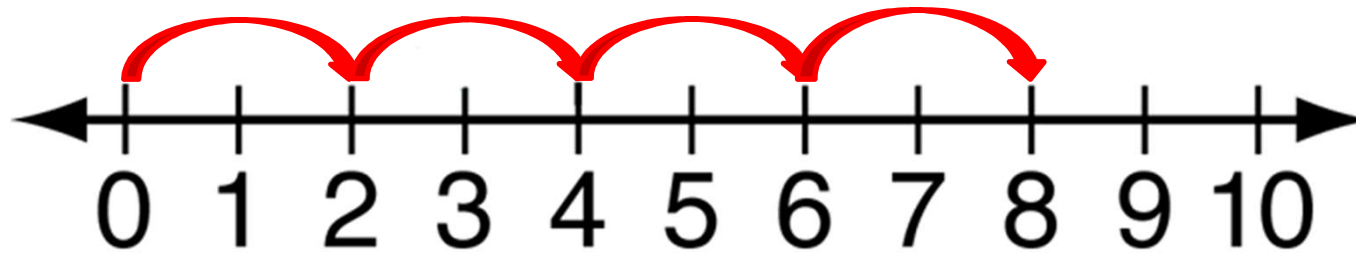
When a number is multiplied by 1, the product is the number itself.

The product of 2 numbers remains the same even after changing the order of the numbers.

When a number is multiplied by 0, the product is always 0



## Multiplication of 2 by 4 using a number line .



$$2+2+2+2=8$$

$$4 \times 2=8$$

CW

1. There are 2 ponds. Each pond has 4 ducks. How many ducks are there in two ponds.



$$\begin{array}{l} \boxed{4} + \boxed{4} = \boxed{8} \quad \text{OR} \quad 2 \text{ times } 4 \text{ equals } \boxed{8} \\ \text{There are } \boxed{2} \times \boxed{4} = \boxed{8} \text{ ducks.} \end{array}$$

**2. A pizza has 6 slices. How many slices will 4 pizzas have?**



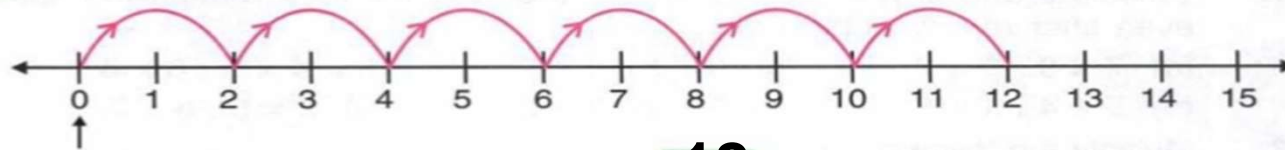
$$6 + 6 + 6 + 6 = 24$$

or

$$4 \times 6 = 24$$



3. Multiplication of 2 by 6 using a number line.

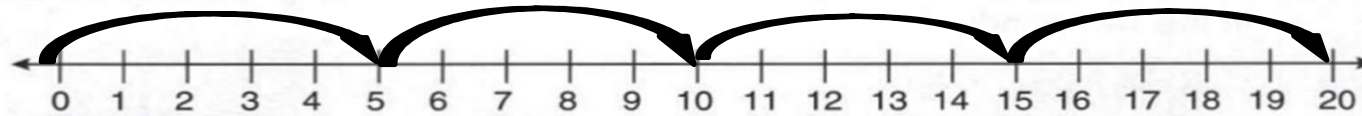


$$2 + 2 + 2 + 2 + 2 + 2 = 12$$

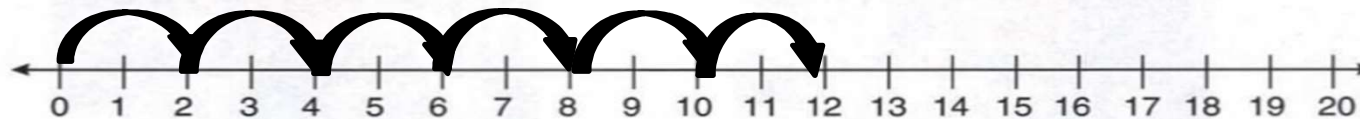
$$6 \times 2 = 12$$

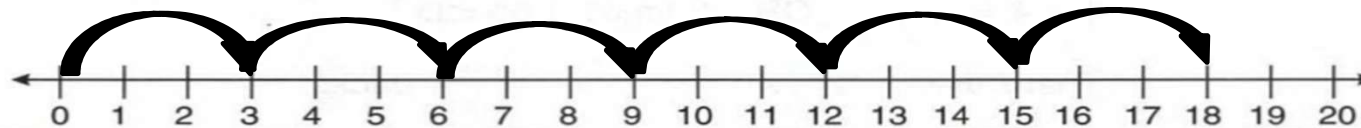

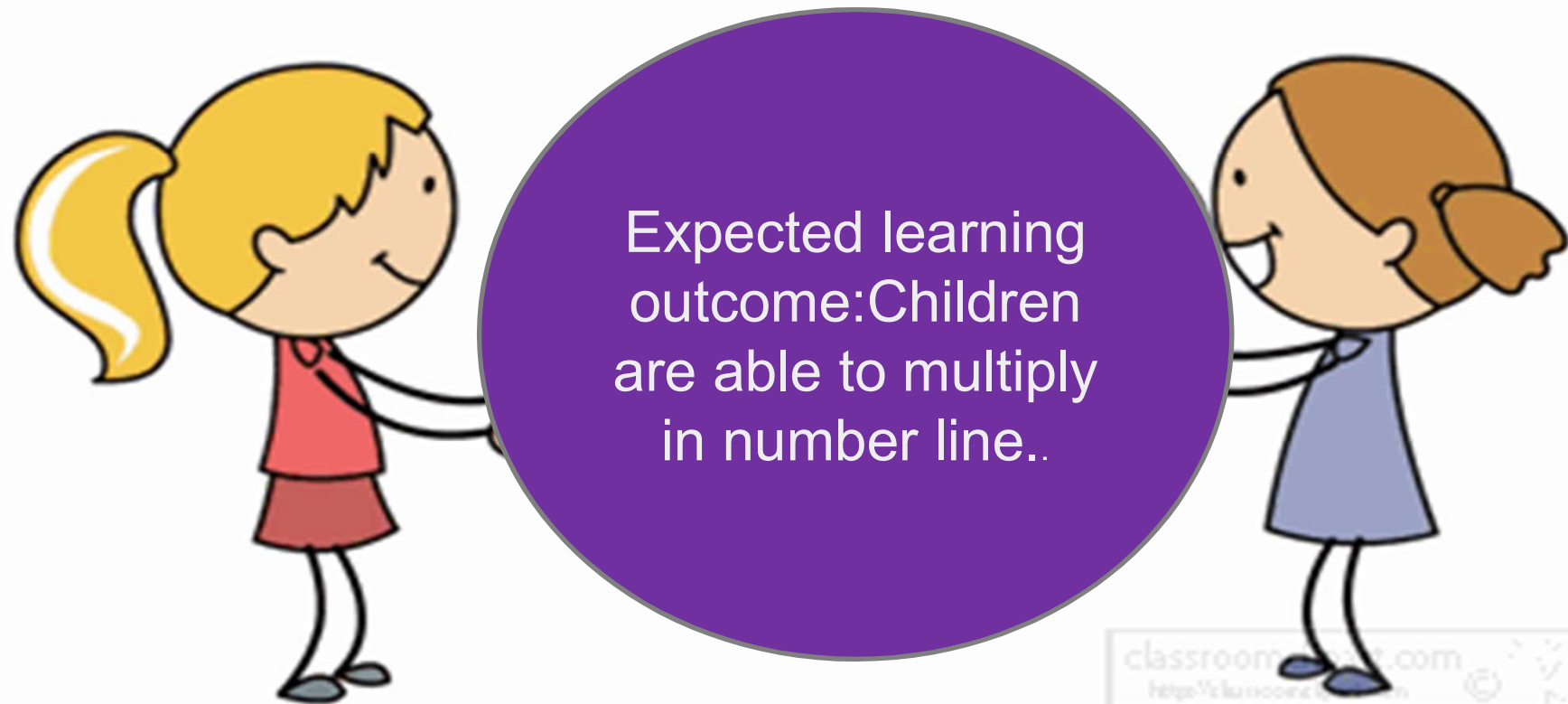
