- i.Earlier they used bows and harpoons to hunt.
- ii.But now they use guns.

iii.The skin and fur of the animals are used to make clothes. iv.The fat is used as fuel.

Fishing:-

i. They used boats called kayaks for fishing in the sea.

ii.Fish processing is the major industry in Greenland.

iii.They hunt seal with the help of harpoon (a kind of spear).



5. What kind of clothes do most people in Greenland wear?

Ans. The people of Greenland wear clothes made of animal skin and fur.

Parkas:- Men, women and children wear jackets with hoods lined with fur, called parkas.

Long boots:- They wear long boot made of seal skin to keep their feet warm in the snow.

6. How have modern facilities changed the lives of the Inuit?

Ans. The lifestyle of Inuits has changed over a period due to the modern facilities such as electricity, permanent houses, schools and hospitals. Now the Inuits are looking towards the modern way of living like-

- Now they are living in wooden houses.
- They eat cooked or canned food.
- They use guns for hunting.
- They use motorized sledges.
- They work in towns.
- They send their children to schools.
- They are getting medical facilities.
