- Cave painting
















- When we share our thoughts, ideas and feelings or exchange information with people

- We can send a letter or telegram to a friend, talk to her over the phone, or send an email.






Long ago, people sent messages through carrier pigeons or had to send someone with the message.

- services are also offered by a number of other private companies in India.










E-mail
