Communication can be of different types:



MASS COMMUNICATION:

Mass communication refers to the transmission of information to a large number of people at the same time. It takes place through mass media and social media.

- Letters
- E-mail
- Video calling through Skype, Facetime over computers or smartphones
- Social networking sites like Facebook Instagram and Twitter

Mass Media

- Till now we have talked about personal communication, or one person sending messages to another.
- But often we also need to send messages to a large number of people at the same time.
- This can be done through newspapers, radio or television. These are called mass media.
- They are means of mass communication, that is, Communication a message to a large number of people.






Mass Media

- News, educational and entertainment programmes telecast on television are watched by millions of people.
- Important sports and cultural events can be shown live (pronounced live') on television.
- This is possible because of satellites.
- Television signals from one part of the world can be sent to another part of the world through satellites.






Mass Media
