# IR VERB CONJUGATION

If an infinitive ends in **-ir**, it means the verb belongs to the second conjugation, for example, **finir**, **choisir**, **remplir**.

The stem of **-ir** verbs in the present tense is formed by taking the infinitive and chopping off **-ir**. Now add the correct ending, depending on whether you are referring to **je**, **tu**, **il**, **elle**, **on**, **nous**, **vous**, **ils** or **elles**.

Infinitive	Stem (without <b>-ir</b> )
<b>finir</b> (to finish)	<b>fin-</b>
<b>choisir</b> (to choose)	<b>chois-</b>
<b>remplir</b> (to fill, to fill in)	<b>rempl-</b>

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Pronoun	Ending	Add to stem, e.g. <b>fin-</b>	Meanings
<b>je (j')</b>	<b>-is</b>	<b>je finis</b>	I finish I am finishing
<b>tu</b>	<b>-is</b>	<b>tu finis</b>	you finish you are finishing
<b>il elle on</b>	<b>-it</b>	<b>il finit elle finit on finit</b>	he/she/it/one finishes he/she/it/one is finishing
<b>nous</b>	<b>-issons</b>	<b>nous finissons</b>	we finish we are finishing
<b>vous</b>	<b>-issez</b>	<b>vous finissez</b>	you finish you are finishing
<b>ils elles</b>	<b>-issent</b>	<b>ils finissent elles finissent</b>	they finish they are finishing
