- Humans change their environment to satisfy their ever-growing needs for comfort and security.

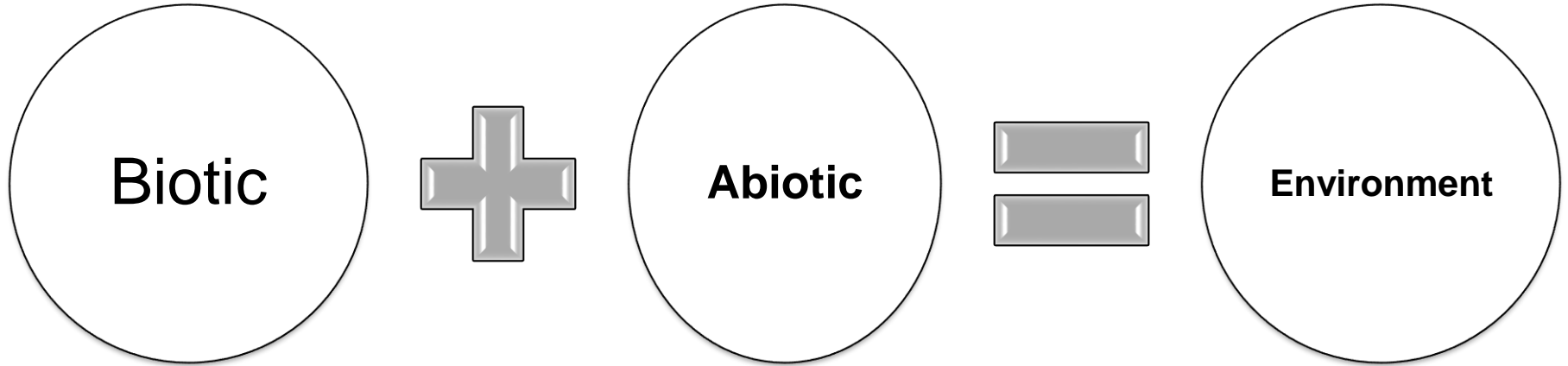


## 1. What is Environment ?

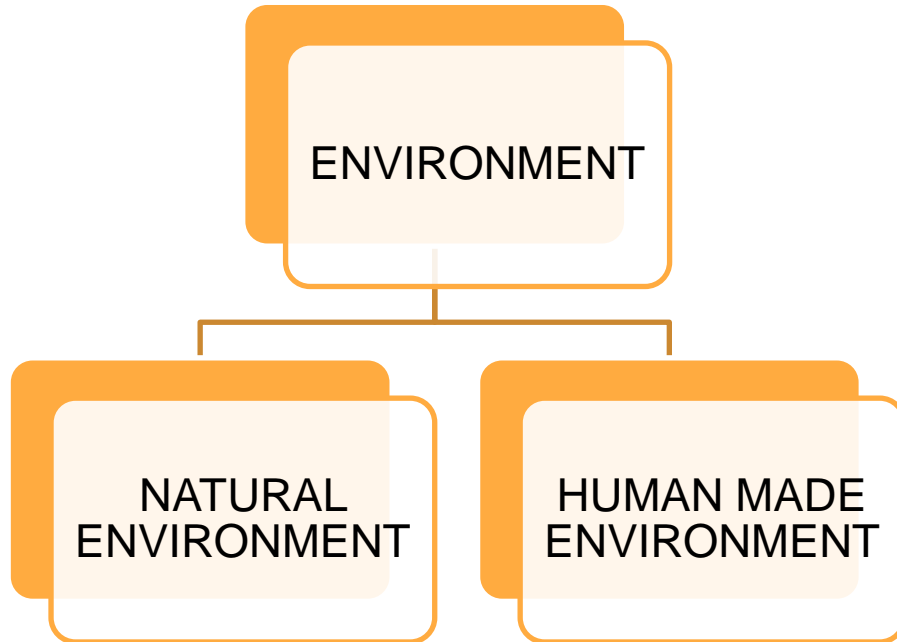
