BODH GAYA

- ❑ Bodh Gaya is a religious site.
- ❑ It is a place of pilgrimage associated with the Mahabodhi Temple in Gaya district in the Indian state of Bihar.



NALANDA

- ❑ The ancient city of Nalanda city was, historically, home to the most ancient university as well.
- ❑ It is declared a 'UNESCO World Heritage Site'.
- ❑ It was the biggest Indian residential university
- ❑ It possess a prestigious treasury of Buddhist knowledge



PUNJAB

- ❑ The word Punjab is a compound of two words, panj (“five”) and “ab (“water”).
- ❑ The land of five waters, or five rivers (the Beas, Chenab, Jhelum, Ravi, and Sutlej).



Qutub Minar:

- ❑ It is the tallest brick minaret in the world.
- ❑ It is surrounded by a beautiful garden and several other historical monuments.
- ❑ It is located in “Delhi” India.
- ❑ The construction of Qutub Minar is done in 12th century.
- ❑ It is five storeyed tower.
- ❑ It is 72 meters high and built by red sandstone.
