Speaker 2 - someone who gets tired very easily and has difficulty paying attention even for a short span of time.



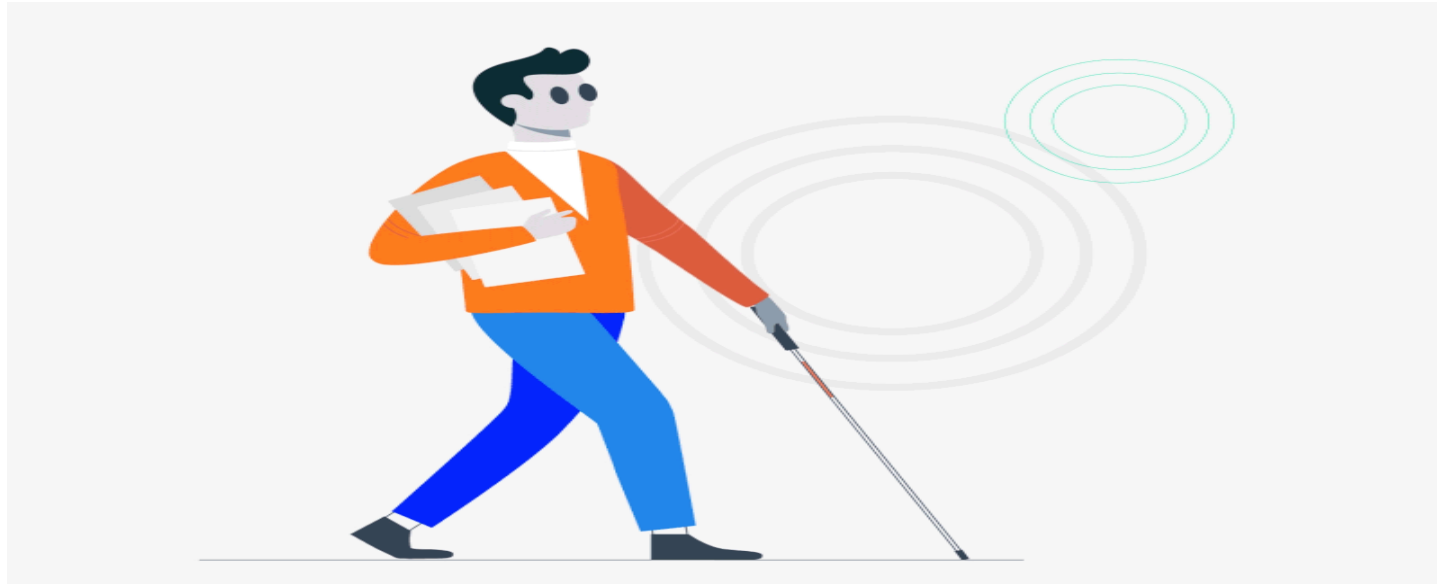
Listening and Speaking junction
