The basic parts of computer system are

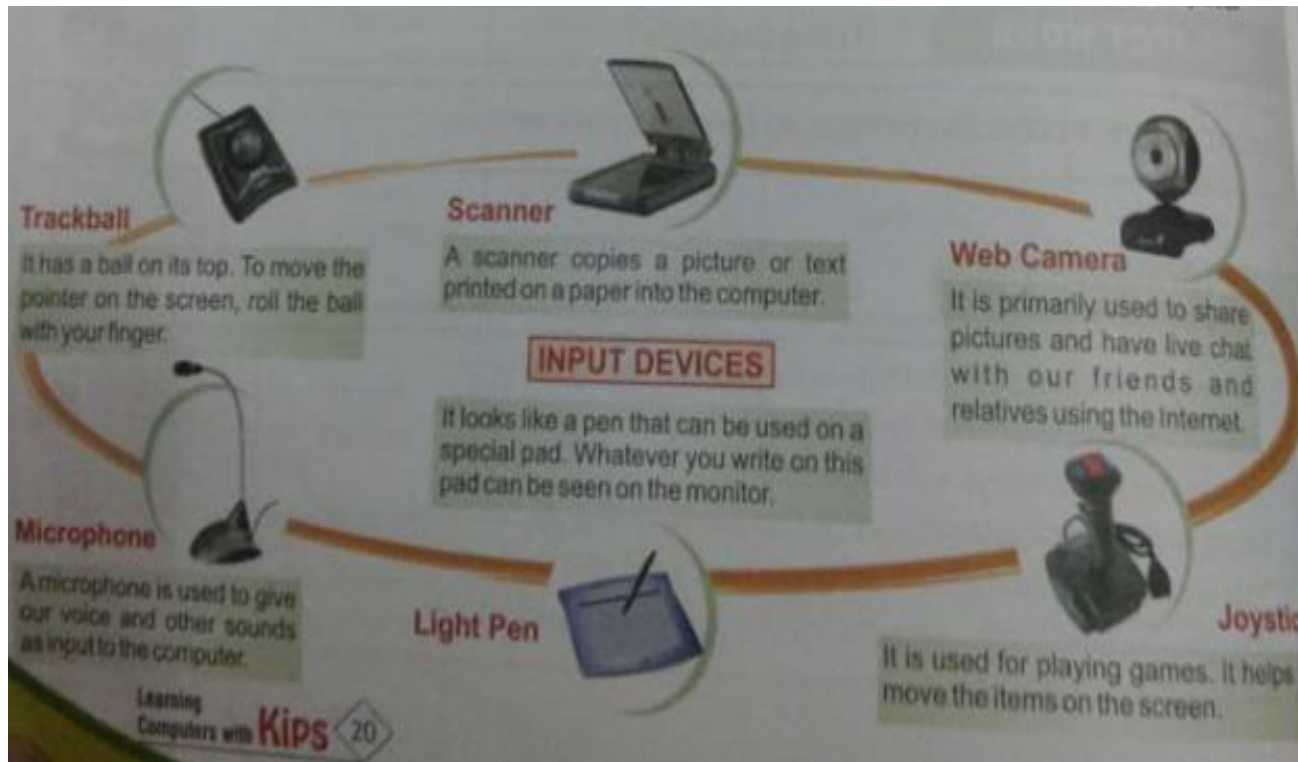
- **HARDWARE**
- **SOFTWARE**

HARDWARE

- The physical parts of a computer that you can touch and feel are called **Hardware**.
- The hardware of a computer is further classified into three parts-Input, Output, and Storage

INPUT DEVICES

- There are special types of hardware devices that are used to input words, numbers, sound, or pictures into a computer. These are called Input devices, e.g., keyboard, mouse, joystick, microphone, etc



OUTPUT DEVICES:

The device that display information and result are called the Output Device. Example: Monitor, printer.



Printer: It prints the output that you see on computer screen on paper



Speaker: It is used to listen sound and music from computer.



Monitor: A monitor looks like a TV screen. It displays the processed information.
