QUANTIFIERS

Most children start school at the age of five.

We ate **some** bread and butter.

We saw **lots** of birds.

The words **most**, **some**, **lots** tells us about quantity. Such words are called quantifiers.

We use quantifiers when we want to give someone information about the number of something: how much or how many.

Different quantifiers are used with countable and uncountable nouns.



- Some words tells us how many people or things are there without stating the number. Many is such a word.
- We use many and a few with countable nouns.
 Much and a little is used with uncountable nouns.
- We use some, all and any with both countable and uncountable nouns.
