# What are Adverbs?

- An adverb is a word that is used to **change or qualify the meaning** of an adjective, a verb, a clause, another adverb.
- Traditionally considered to be a single part of speech, adverbs perform a wide variety of functions. Adverbs normally carry out these functions by answering questions such as:

**When?** She always arrives early.

**How?** He drives carefully.

**Where?** They go everywhere together.

**In what way?** She eats slowly.

**To what extent?** It is terribly hot.
