# CONCRETE NOUNS

A concrete noun is a noun that can be identified through one of the five senses ( taste, touch, sight, hearing or smell).

Phone

In the sentence above, the noun phone is a concrete noun. You can touch it , see it, hear it, and may be even smell it .

## Abstract nouns

An abstract noun is a noun that refers to an intangible concept such as an emotion, a feeling, a quality or an idea. In other words, an abstract noun does not refer to a physical object.

He felt he would burst with anger and shame.
