When we compare two people, place, things or animals we use comparative adjectives.

she is two years older than me.

we need a bigger garden.

France is bigger than Britain.

We usually add -er to make comparative adjectives.

Superlative adjective express the extreme or highest degree of a quality of one thing in a group of things.

- It was the happiest day of my life.
- Jan is the oldest and Angela is the youngest.

We usually add -est to make superlative adjectives.
