

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5 ELEMENTS OF A STORY

- 1. Character
 - A character is a person or something even an animal who takes part in the action of a story.
- 2. Setting
 - It is the time and place in which it happens. Authors often use description of scenery, seasons or weather to provide armstrong sense of setting.
- 3. Plot
 - A plot is a series of events and actions that relate to the central conflict.



5 ELEMENTS OF A STORY

4.Conflict

The conflict is a struggle between two people or things in a story.

5.Theme

The theme is the central idea or belief in a story.
