5 ELEMENTS OF A STORY

1. Character

A character is a person or something even an animal who takes part in the action of a story.

2. Setting

It is the time and place in which it happens. Authors often use description of scenery, seasons or weather to provide a strong sense of setting.

3. Plot

A plot is a series of events and actions that relate to the central conflict.

5 ELEMENTS OF A STORY

4. Conflict

The conflict is a struggle between two people or things in a story.

5. Theme

The theme is the central idea or belief in a story.
