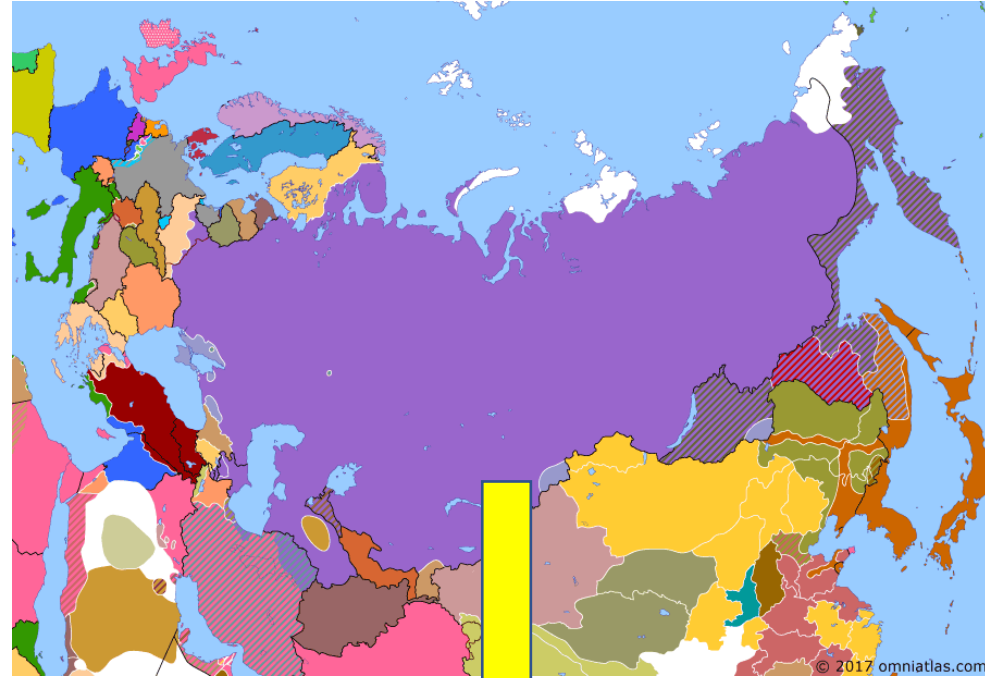

Started career in 1949 at Boston University School of Medicine.

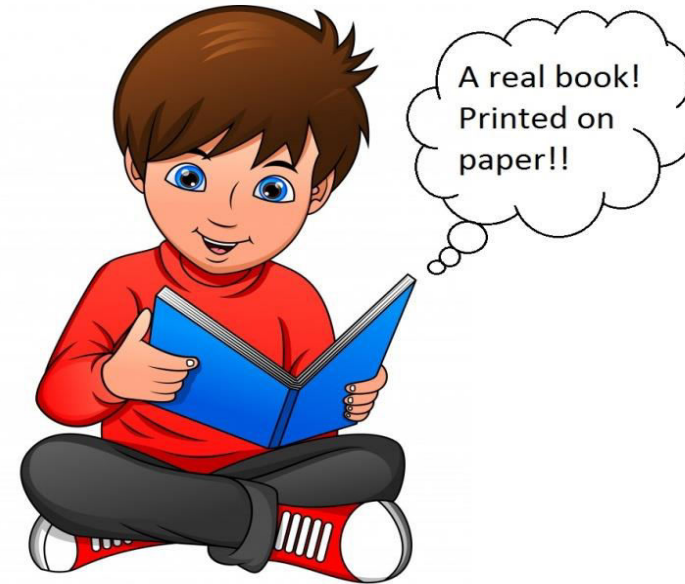
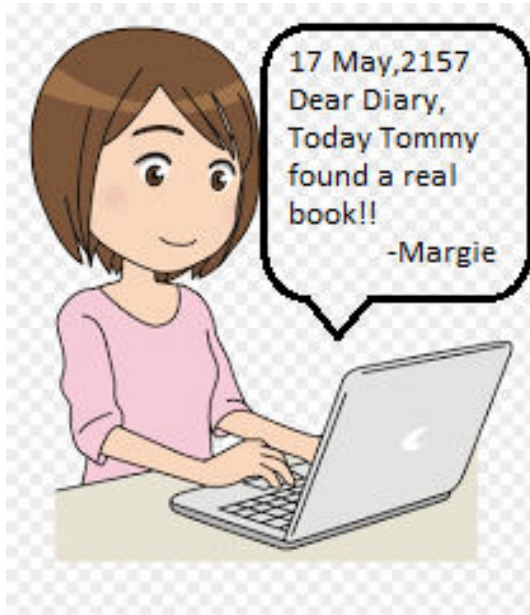


Became an Associate Professor of Biochemistry in 1955.

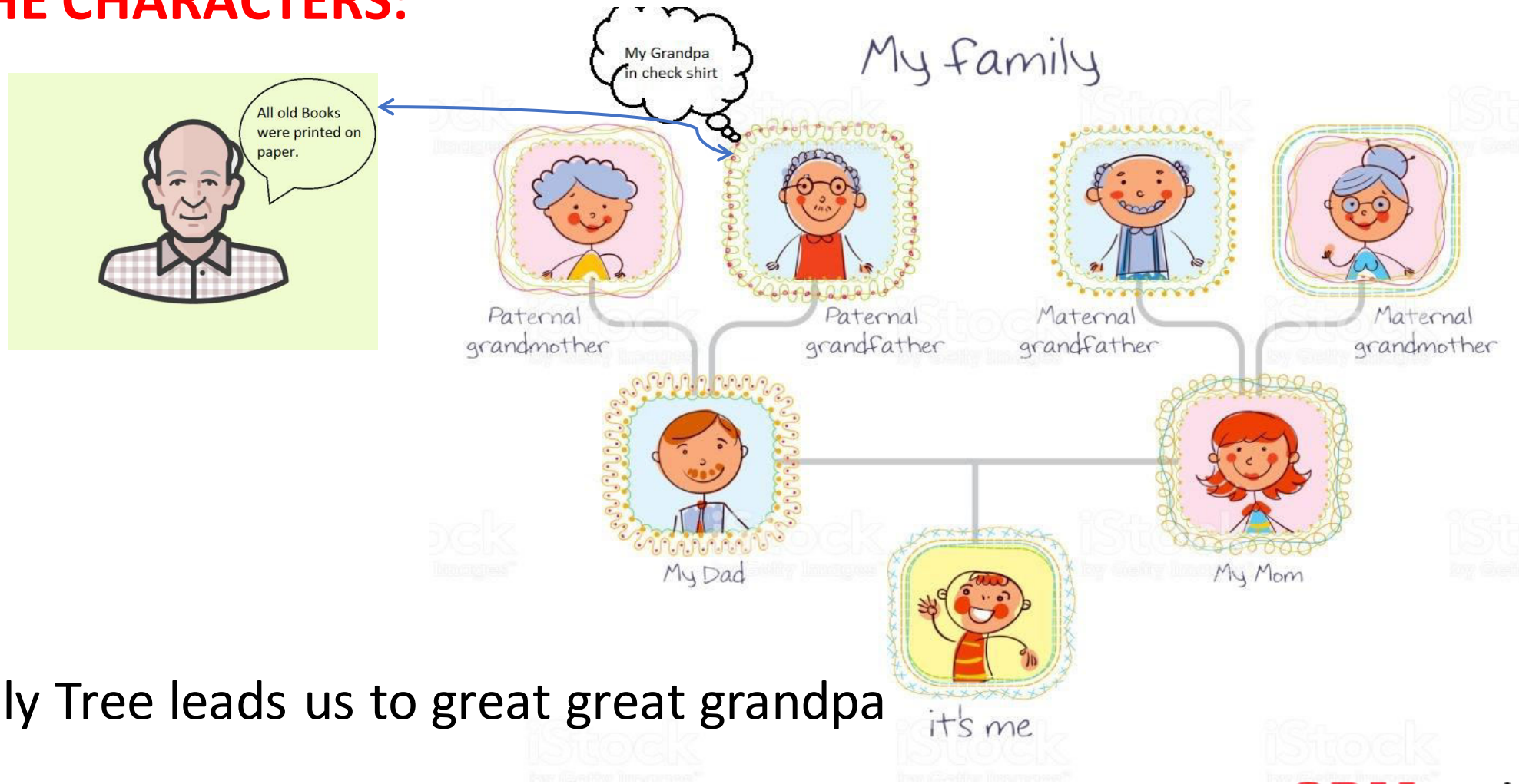
# Margie & Tommy

- "Each kid has to be taught differently."

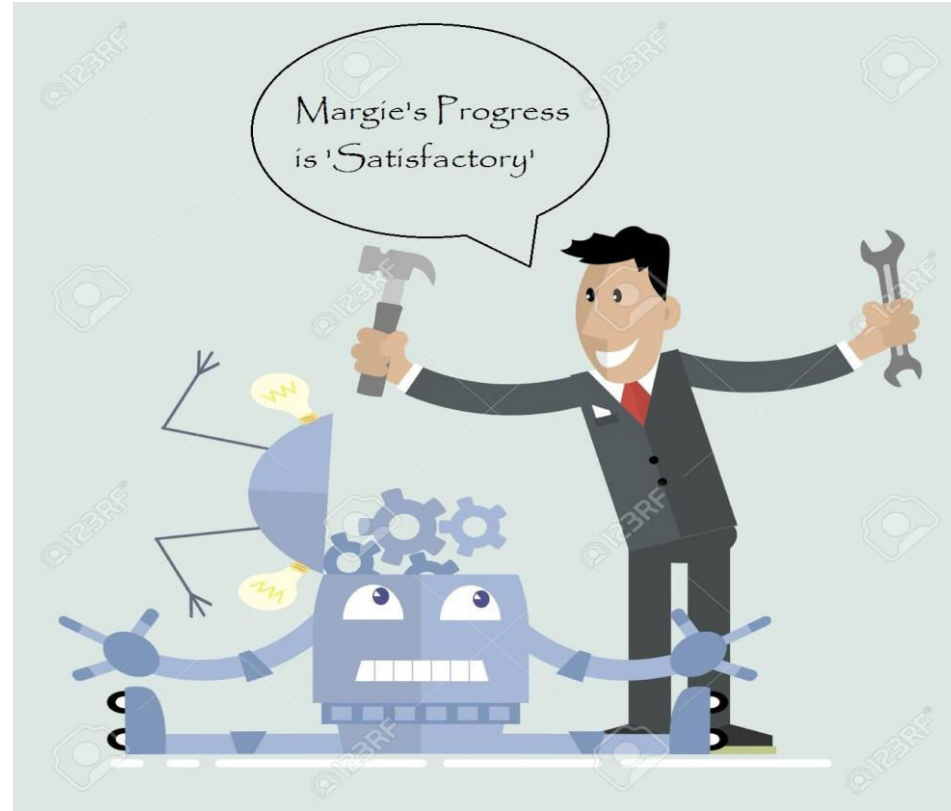
## MEETING THE CHARACTERS:
