Adverbs of Degree

Adverbs of **Degree** helps a speaker express the intensity of a verb or extent to which something happens

I am **so** excited about moving to Paris.

Kate is **very** beautiful.

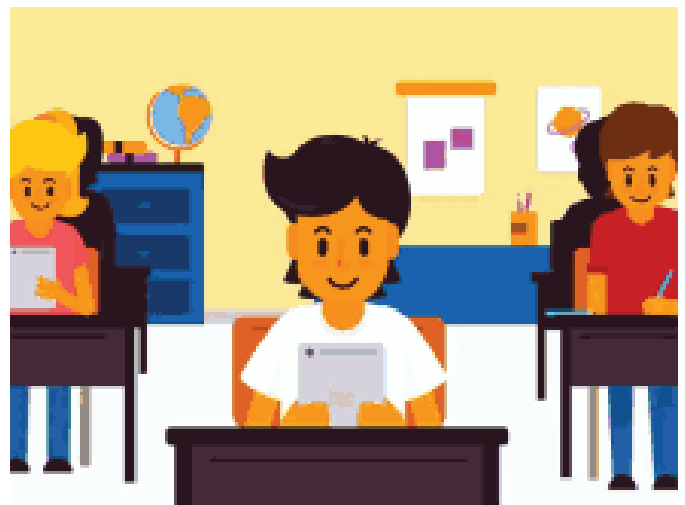
