Adverbs of Degree

Adverbs of **Degree** helps a speaker express the intensity of a verb or extent to which something happens

I am **so** excited about moving to Paris.

Kate is very beautiful.

Almost Enough Hardly Just Nearly Quite Simply So Too Fully Perfectly Terribly

Adverb of Purpose/Reason

The adverb which tells about a reason is called adverb of reason.

Examples:

- He is hence unable to refute the charge.
- · He therefore left school.
- We all go for a picnic just for enjoyment.
