Am, Is and Are

STUDY NOTESAt a glance:

- We use **'am, 'is, 'are'** when we want to describe someone or something or talk about somebody's job in the present time.
- The words **am, is, are**, always used with nouns and pronouns.
- **Am** is always used with the pronoun **I**. We use **am** to talk about ourselves.
- We use **is** to talk about one person, animal, place or thing. We also use **is** with the pronouns **she, he** and **it**.
- We use **are** to talk about more than one person, animal, place or thing.
- We also use **are** with the pronouns **we** and **they**.




