A computer cannot take its own decisions.

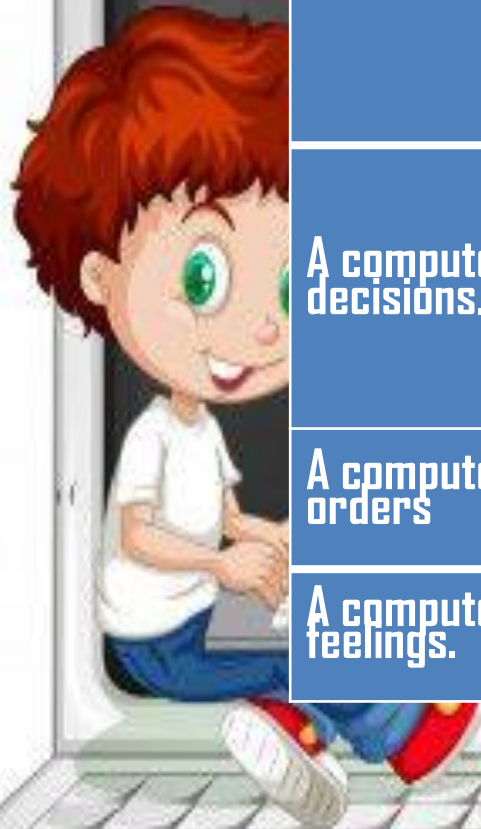
Humans can take their own decisions.

- Doing Homework.




- Keeping records of books and helping teachers in teaching.
