HUMAN DEVELOPMENT INDEX AND BMI

- Ø **HUMAN DEVELOPMENT REPORT** Published by the **UNDP** compares countries based on the educational levels of the people, their health status and per capita income.
- Ø India's HDI ranking-130
- Ø Total countries-188 (2014) at present- 199
- Ø Sri Lanka's HDI ranking-73 (2014)
- Human Development Index covers Literacy rate, Infant mortality rate, and Body Mass Index, Life expectancy and health facilities
 - Ø BMI-Body Mass Index
 - Ø BMI= Weight in kg divided by height in meter square
 - Ø If result is **less than 18.5** then person is undernourished If BMI is **more than 25** then the person is overweight.


