## Definition

- **Adverb:** a word that describes a verb, an adjective, or another adverb.

Example:

- She drives **carefully**.
- She's a **very** good driver.
- She drives **really** well.

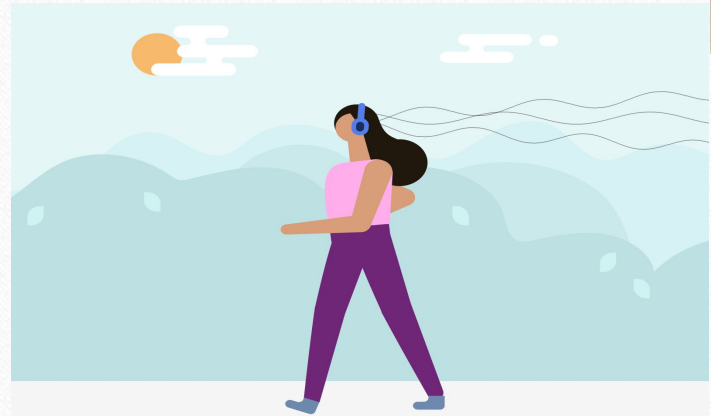

# Adverbs of frequency

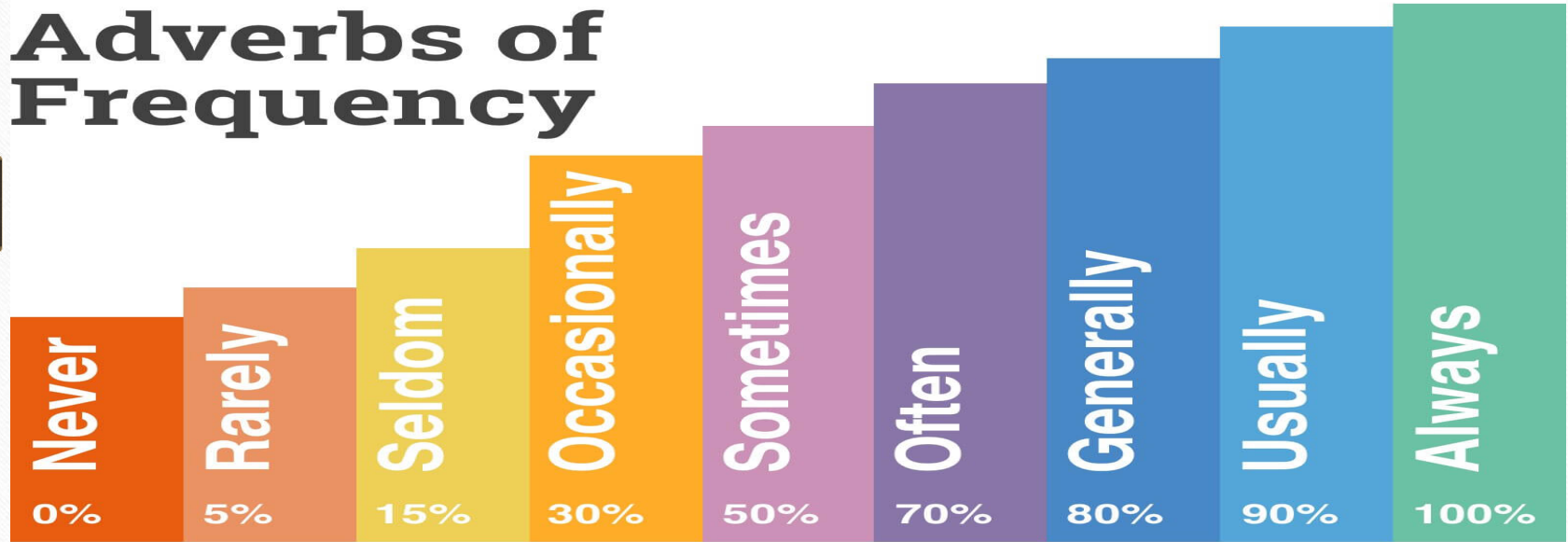
It talks about the frequency of an action, or how often something happens.

Ex- always , often , sometimes ,regularly, rarely, monthly, weekly, never, seldom, yearly, ever, hardly

**Adverbs of frequency have different positions in a sentence.  
These adverbs can be placed before the main verb.**

scale of adverbs in decreasing order of their frequency
