Ans c. The people belonged to Hamelin, a small town in Germany.

2. 'Look! The Pied Piper...It was an extraordinary sight..'

Ans a. An excited small girl from the crowd said the above line.

Ans b. The rats following the Pied Piper towards the jungle was an extra ordinary sight

Ans c. The name of the lesson is 'The Pied Piper of Hamelin'

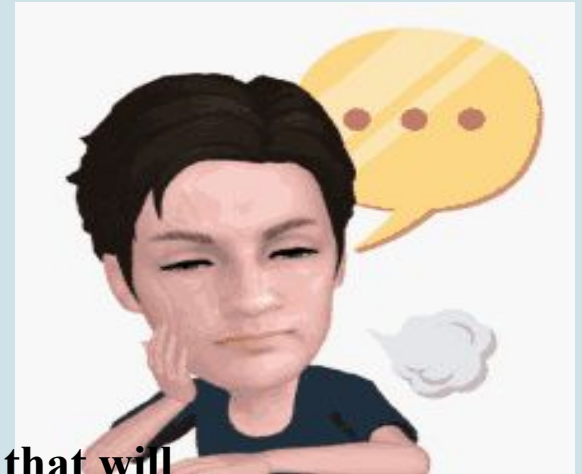
Speaking junction

I suggest or
advise that...

I think you
should or
could...

I would like
to suggest
that...
