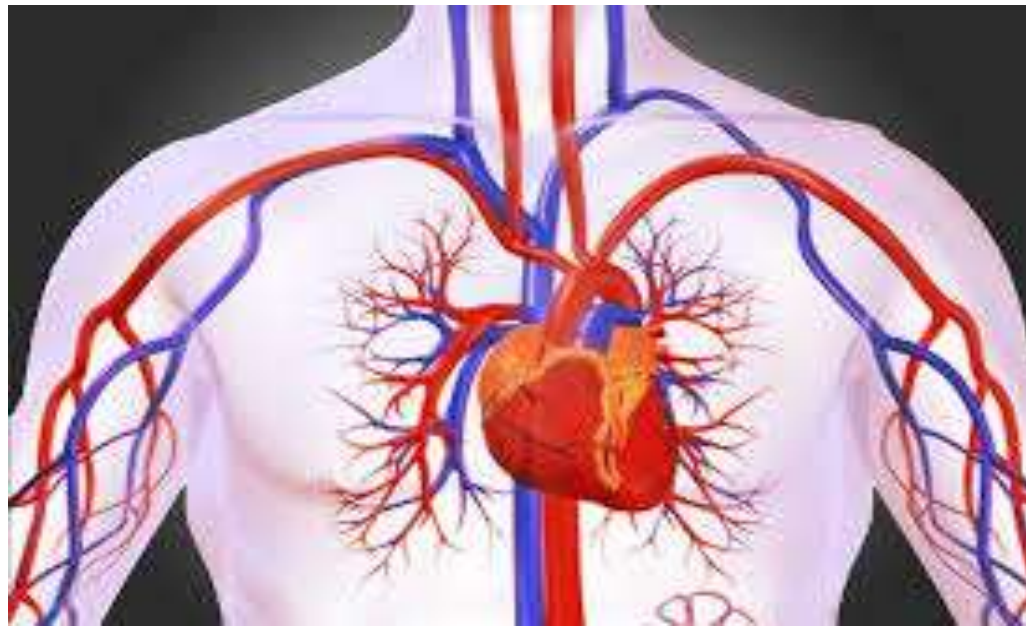

CIRCULATORY SYSTEM

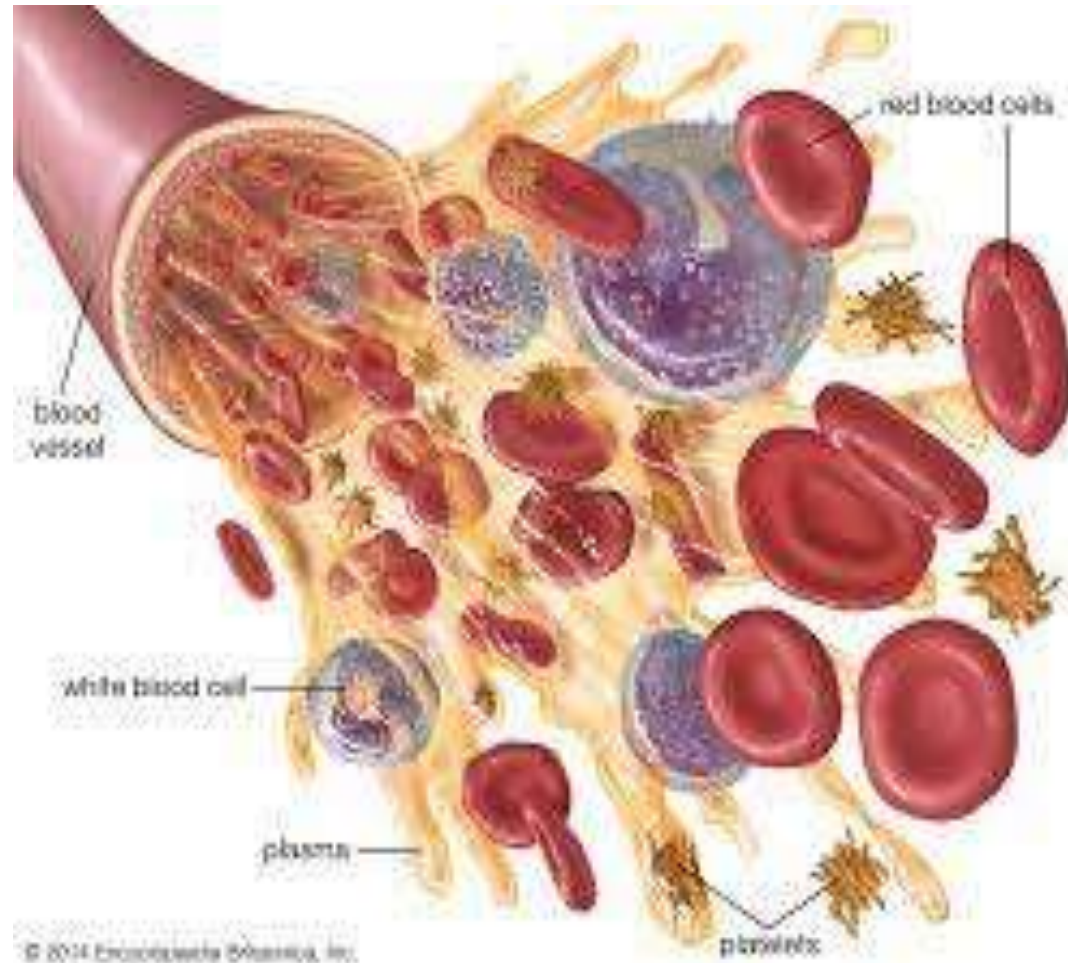

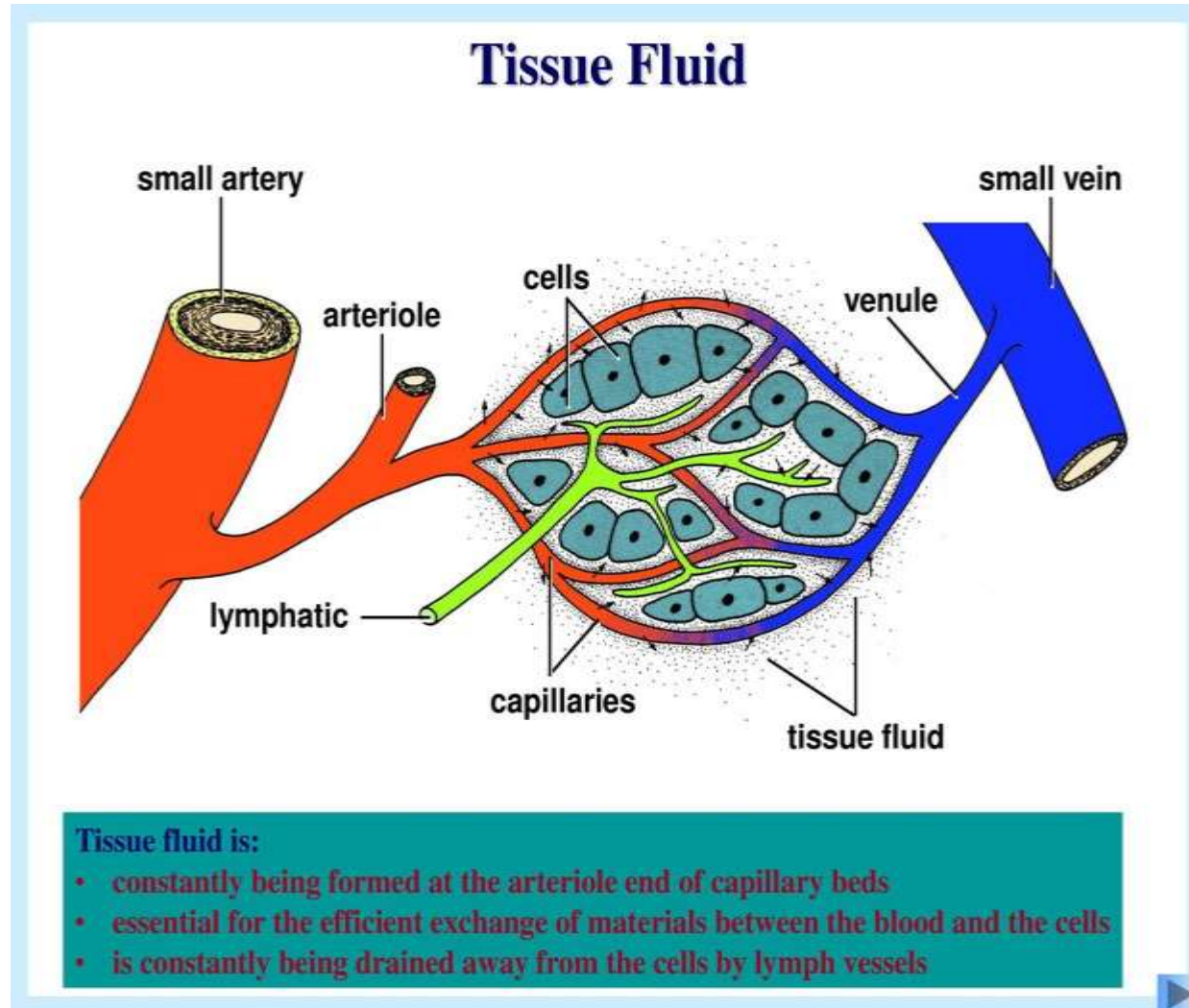
PRINCIPAL FLUIDS

Tissue fluid

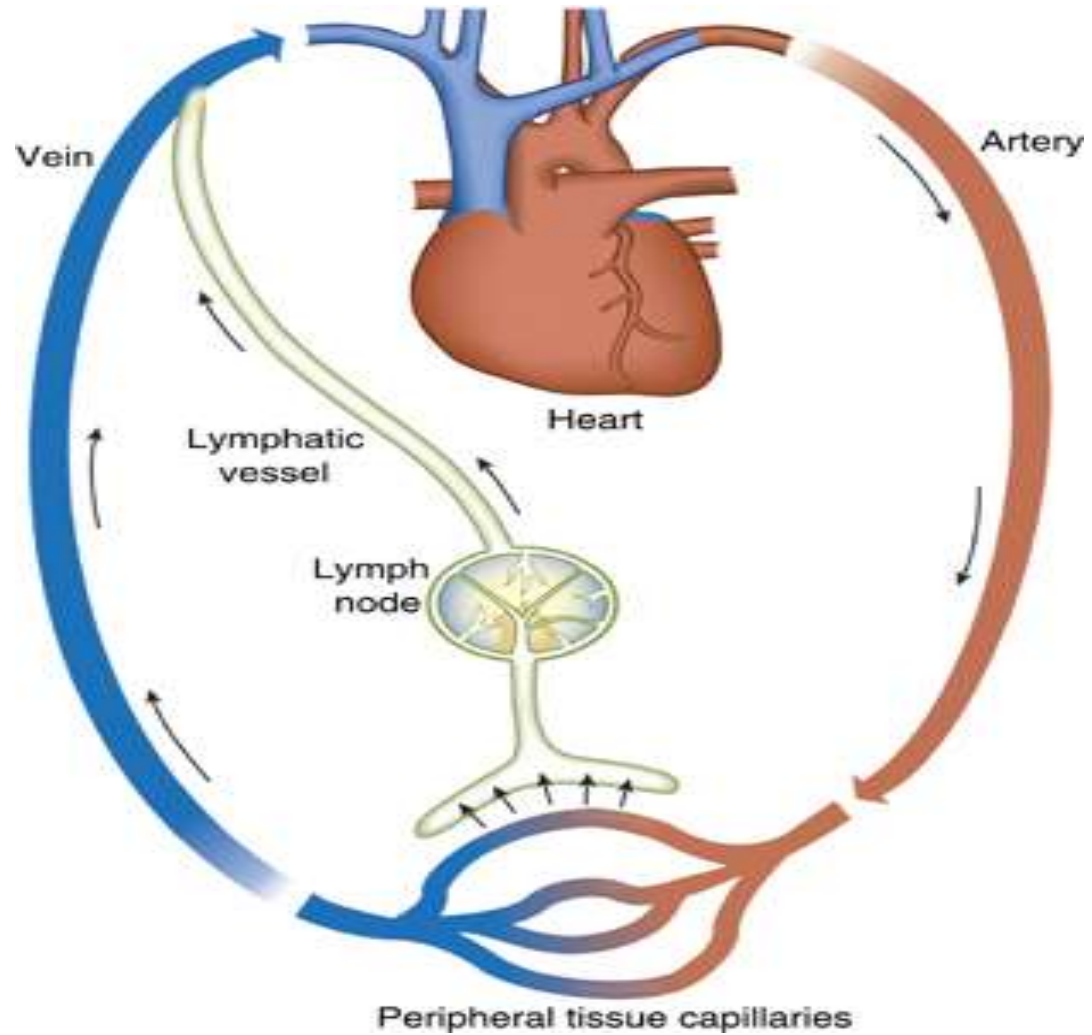


lymph
