- ❑ By celebrating different festivals, we share our happiness to others and make them feel happy too.







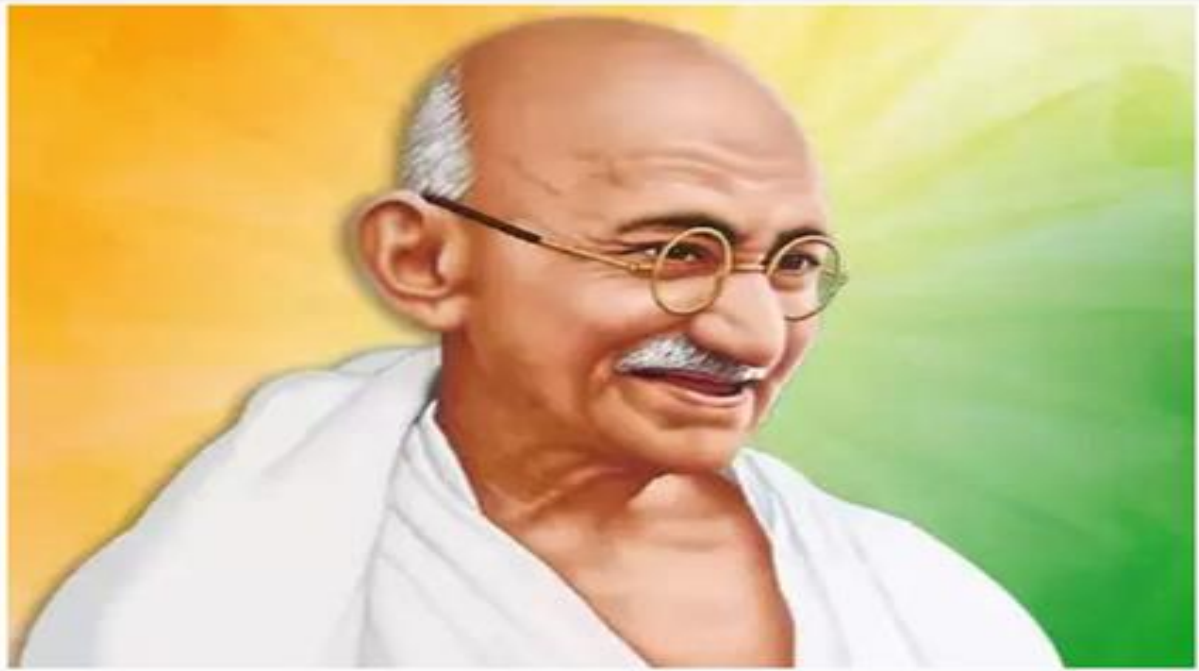

- ❑ There is a grand parade in front of India gate in New Delhi.



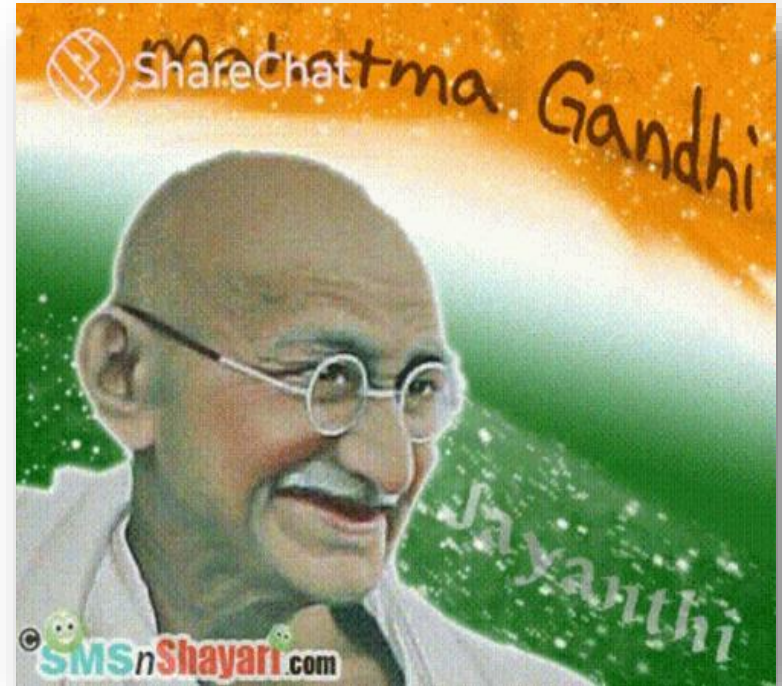
INDEPENDENCE DAY :-
