

DIFFERENCE BETWEEN GULF AND BAY





STRAIT


One difference between a gulf and a bay is quite difficult to distinguish as they both have the same characteristics. In technical terms, both a gulf and a bay are the same things, and the only difference that is pointed out is in the size. A gulf is much larger than a bay.

A gulf is said to be a large body of water that is surrounded by land and having only a narrow entrance along a strait.

A bay is also a large body of <u>water</u> that is surrounded by land but not as enclosed as a gulf. Moreover, the bay has a wider opening than the gulf.

A Strait- A Narrow Stretch Of Water Which Separate Two Land Mass.


WATER BODIES AROUND INDIA







- Covering an area of 3.28 million square kilometer, India's total area is 2.4% of the total geographical area of the world.
- ➤India is the world's seventh largest country with a land boundary of about 15,200 km, with total length of the coastline being 7,516.6 km.
- ➤ India's east-west extent appears to be smaller than the north-south extent.
- Longitudinal and Latitudinal extent of the mainland is about 30degree.
- From Gujarat to Arunachal Pradesh there is a time lag of two hours. Time along standard meridian is taken as the standard time of the country.
- ➤ Standard Meridian of India is 82degree30'E that passes through Mirzapur (UP).
