- ❑ They go to church and offer special prayers.



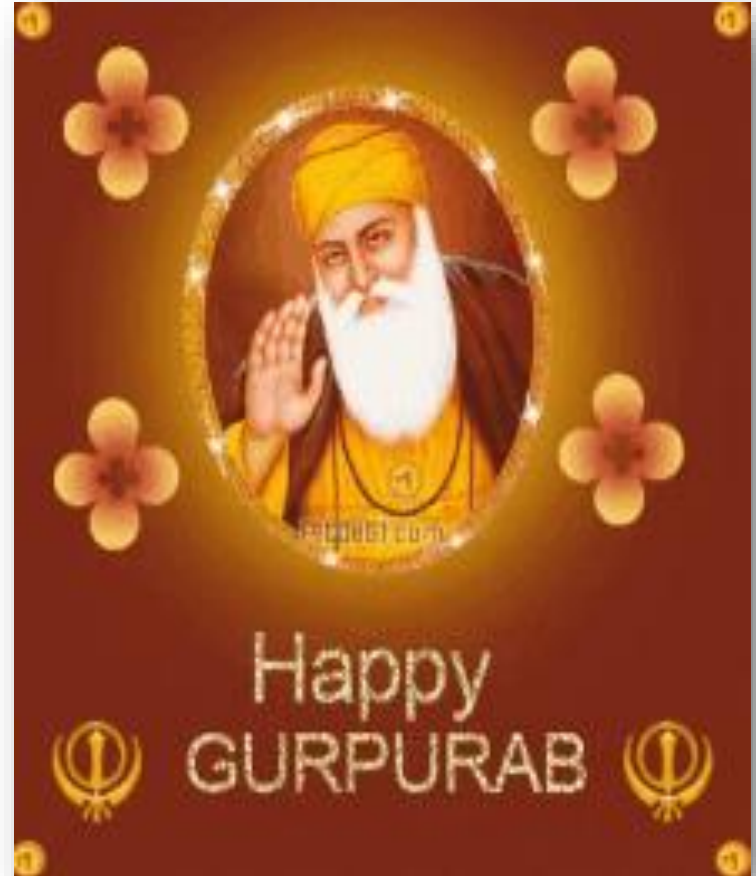
DIWALI :-
