*Gerund*



**A Gerund is like a blend of verbs and nouns.  
It looks like a verb, but it acts like a noun.**

**Ex:- Swimming is my favourite sport.  
They love eating fish.**

# Gerunds

A gerund is a noun made from a verb by adding **ing**

Usage	Example
Subject	<b>Running</b> is good for your heart.
Direct Object	He hates <b>waking</b> up early.
Subject Complement	What I dislike most is <b>repeating</b> myself.
Object Complement	I saw Tom <b>riding</b> his bike.
Object of a Preposition	I am interested in <b>improving</b> myself.
Object of a Possessive	She does not like your <b>bossing</b> her around.



## Gerund after prepositions

I am **good at playing** volleyball.

preposition gerund

Ex: (to) be interested in

**After taking** a shower she went to bed.

preposition gerund

Ex: before, while

They never **apologize for being** late.

preposition gerund

Use adjective & preposition preposition (alone)  
verb & preposition
