4. Which part of India is a peninsula?

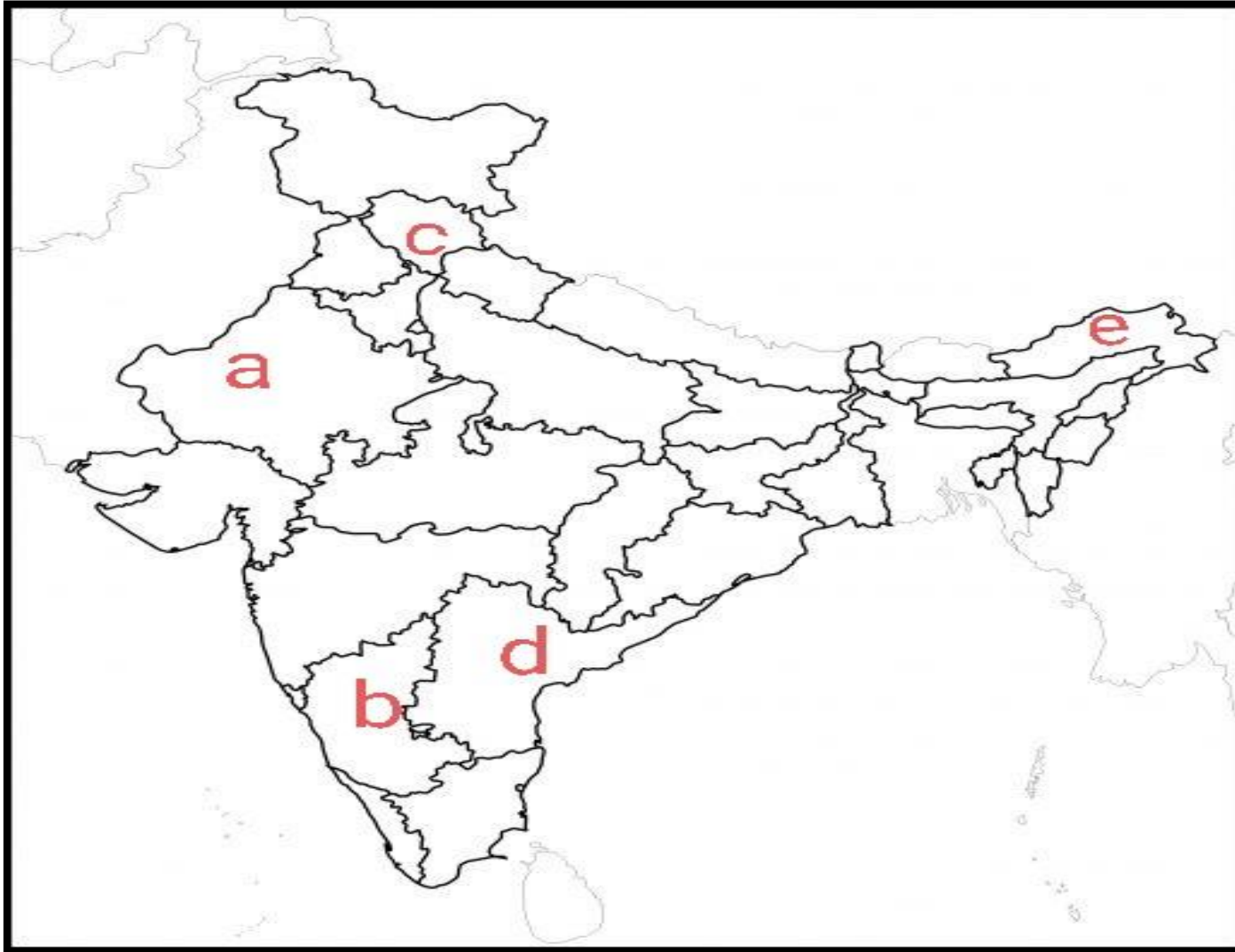
Ans . The southern part of India is a peninsula. The Indian peninsula has the Bay of Bengal in east , Arabian sea in the west and Indian Ocean in south.
