

Let's recap



- The girls have **long** hair.
- Raju is **young** but **grandpa** is old.
- John has a **new** toy, jimmy has an **old** toy.

The bold words are adjectives as they are describing the qualities or states of the nouns.

- **Each** girl will get a chocolate.
- He used to call me **everyday**.
- I like **neither** of you.
- Is there **any** money left?

Each, every, neither, any are referring to individual members of a group.

Adjectives that refer to individual members of a group are called distributive adjectives.

Some examples- each, every, neither, either, any, both etc.

- **Each** is used to describe and highlight an individual member of a group, or multiple individuals.
- By using **each** you recognize the item is a part of a group, but that also needs to be pointed out as singular item.

Ex-

EACH PERSON IS WEARING A DIFFERENT COSTUME.



- **Every** is used to the group as a collection of individual members.
- **Every** cannot be used with plural nouns.
- **Every** can express different points in a series, especially with time expressions.

Ex-

EVERY STUDENT IS ENCOURAGED TO PARTICIPATE IN DIFFERENT COMPETITIONS.
