In this lesson, we're going to go over the days of the week in French as well as spend some time using them in the same context that you likely learned the days of the week in English--as weekdays and the weekend.

Days of the Week in English and French

English	French
Monday	lundi (pronounced: lun-dee)
Tuesday	mardi (pronounced like: Mardi Gras)
Wednesday	mercredi (pronounced: mer-cra-dee)
Thursday	jeudi (pronounced: ju-dee)
Friday	vendredi (pronounced: von-dra-dee)
Saturday	samedi (pronounced: sa-mey-dee)
Sunday	dimanche (pronounced: dee-man-sh)

hier	yesterday	yehr
cette semaine	this week	seht suh-mehn
la semaine prochaine	next week	lah suh-mehn proh-shehn
la semaine dernière	last week	lah suh-mehn dehr-nyah
un jour	a day	uh(n) zhoor
une semaine	a week	ewn suh-mehn
un mois	a month	uh(n) mwah
un an	a year	uh(n) nah(n)

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
