Days of the Week in English and French

| English | French |
|-----------|-------------------------------------|
| Monday | lundi (pronounced: lun-dee) |
| Tuesday | mardi (pronounced like: Mardi Gras) |
| Wednesday | mercredi (pronounced: mer-cra-dee) |
| Thursday | jeudi (pronounced: ju-dee) |
| Friday | vendredi (pronounced: von-dra-dee) |
| Saturday | samedi (pronounced: sa-mey-dee) |
| Sunday | dimanche (pronounced: dee-man-sh) |

un mois a month uh(n) mwah

un an a year uh(n) nah(n)
