

- They will collect the information from the recent survey and write the situation of air pollution before and after the lockdown during Covid-19.

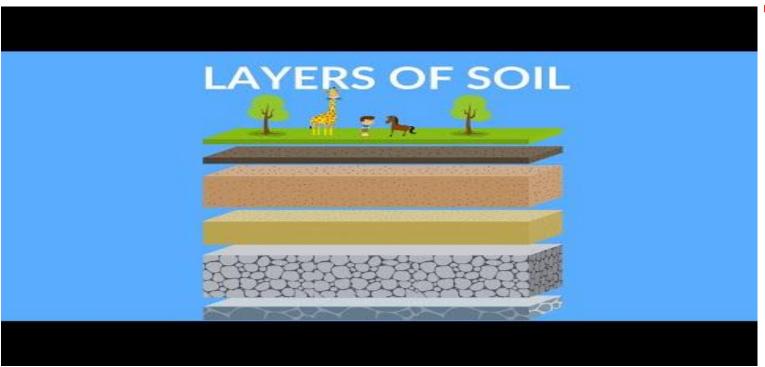
