Story time

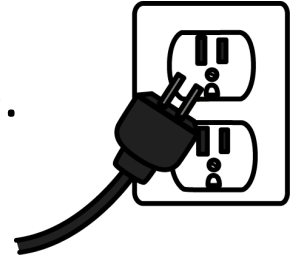

❖ We can be safe and avoid getting hurt by being careful.

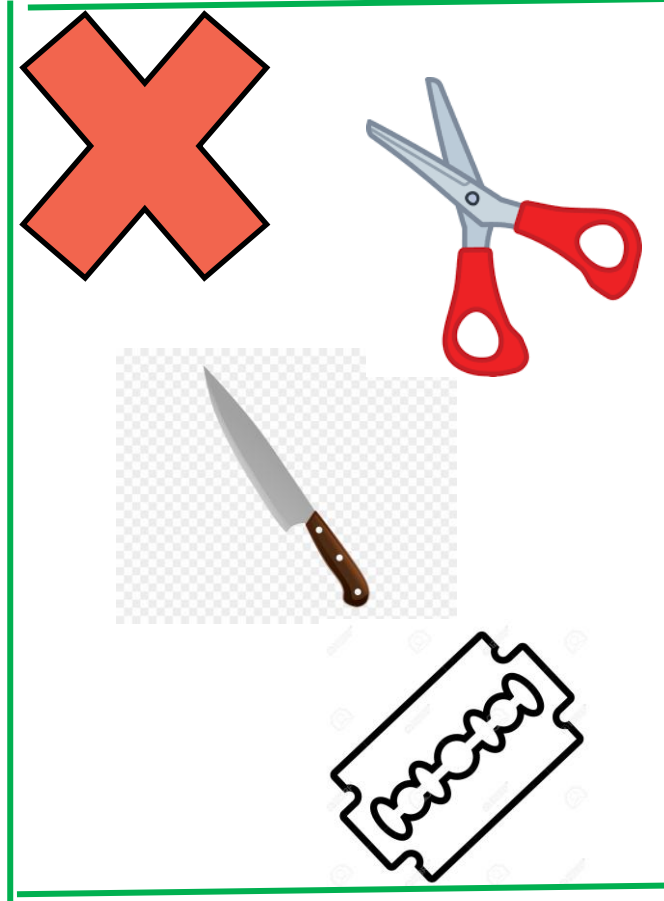

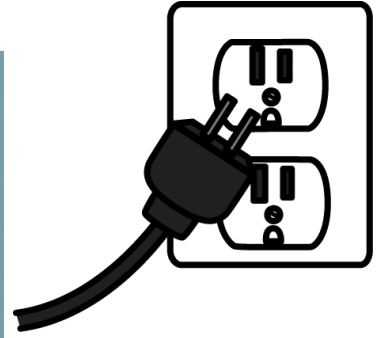
1. Do not play with fire.
