



<u>Method</u>

Step-1. Spread the piece of cloth/paper on the table.

Step -2. Cut the lady finger in to two parts.

step-3. Pour some colour on the plate.

Step-4. Dip the lady finger into the colour and paste it on the cloth/paper.

Step-5. Your printed handkerchief/ paper is ready to use.
