VIDEO ON THE EARTH AND THE SKY

- Land is used for our living.

LAND



➤ Flatlands are called plains.



➤ The higher areas that rise above the plains are called mountains and hills.



➤ Deserts are hot and dry parts of land.

➤ They are covered with sand.

- Most of our earth is covered with water.
- Water is found in various water bodies, such as oceans, seas, rivers, ponds and lakes.



AIR



- Air is present all around us.
- We cannot see air but we can feel it when it moves.
- We breathe in air.



THE SKY

- We can see the blue sky above us when we look up.
- During the day , the sun shines brightly to give us light and heat.
- We can also see clouds in the sky.
- Dark clouds bring rain.
- We can see a rainbow in the sky on a rainy day.
- At night, the sky becomes dark.
- At night, we can see the moon and the twinkling stars in the sky.
