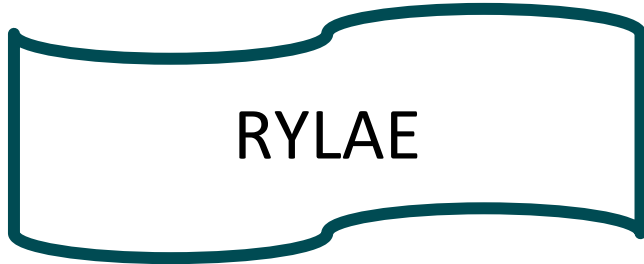

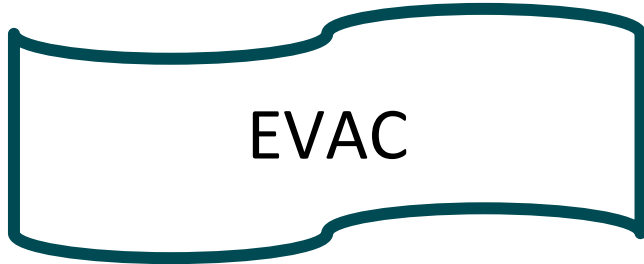

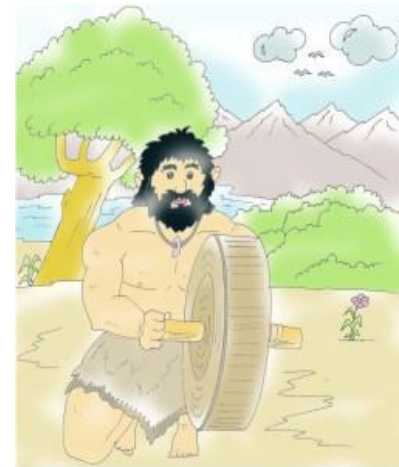
Uses of fire and wheel.
