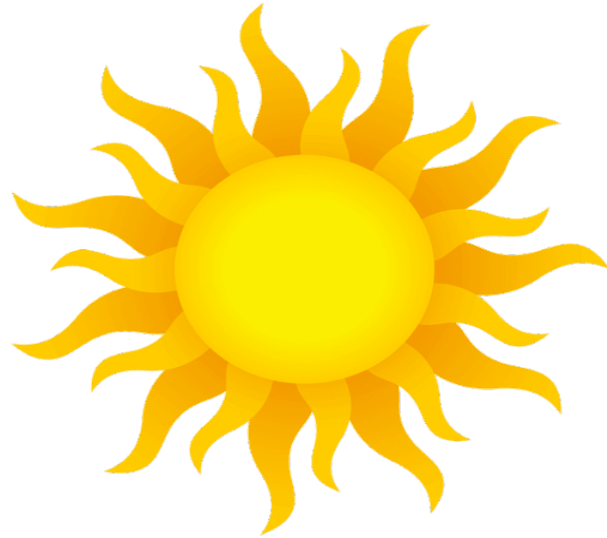

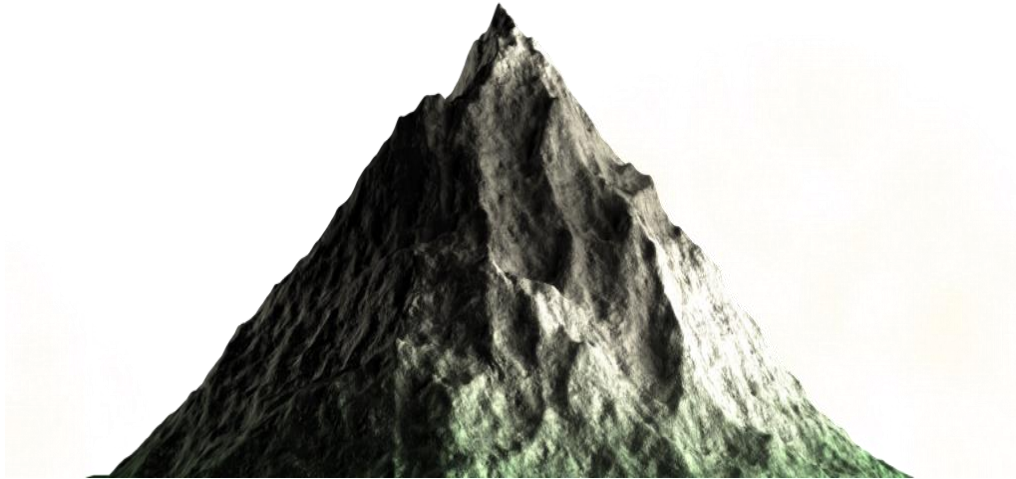

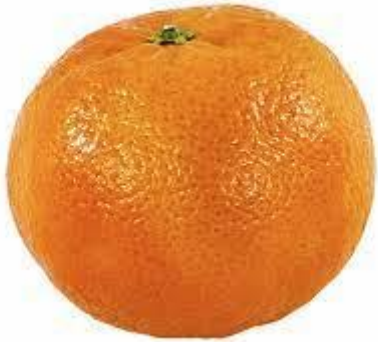

The Earth



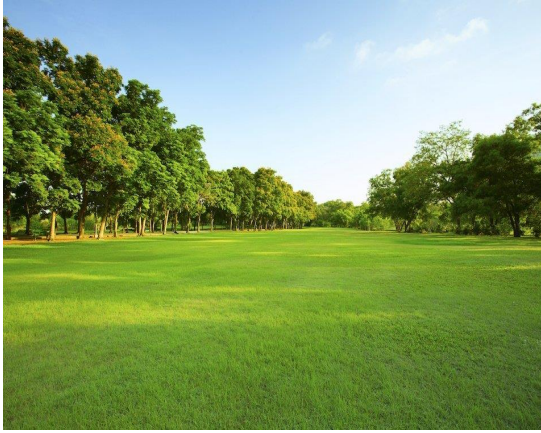
Orange
