
Chapter- 7

Pronouns - I, You, He, She, It, We and They

STUDY NOTES

At a glance:

- Words that are used in place of naming words are called pronouns.
- I, You, He, She, It, We and They are some of the pronouns.
- Let's learn how to use pronouns.
 - The pronoun I is used to talk about oneself.
 I am Mohan. I like drawing and painting.
 - The pronoun you is used to talk about the person to whom we are speaking.
 You are very kind.
 - The pronoun he is used in place of the name of a male person.
 Ram is my friend. He is very smart.
 - The pronoun she is used in place of the name of a female person.
 Rita is my best friend. She wants to be a doctor.
 - The pronoun it is used in place of the name of an animal or a thing.
 The dog is barking. It is hungry.
 - The pronoun we is used in place of the name of more than one person including ourselves.
 - Seema, Rohini and I are friends. We play together.
 - The pronoun they is used in place of the name of more than one person. They is used to talk about others.
 - Tony and Tia have a pet dog. **They** play with their dog.
