# What are Vowels?

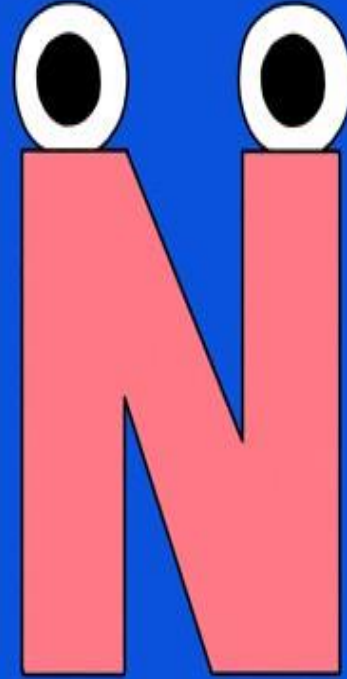
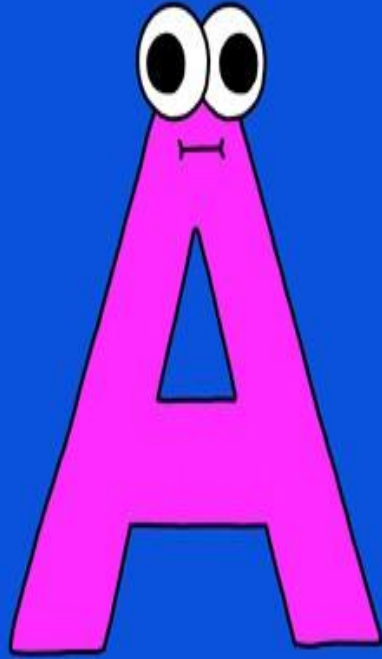
