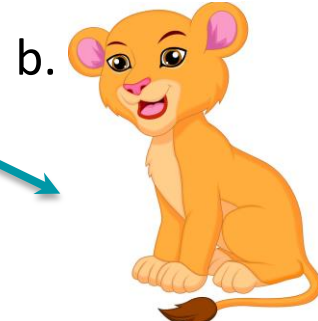
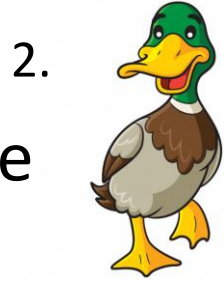
A word that is used to name a male person or animal is called a **male naming word**.

A word that is used to name a female person or animal is called a **female naming word**.

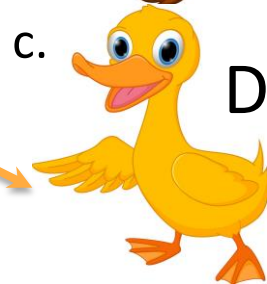

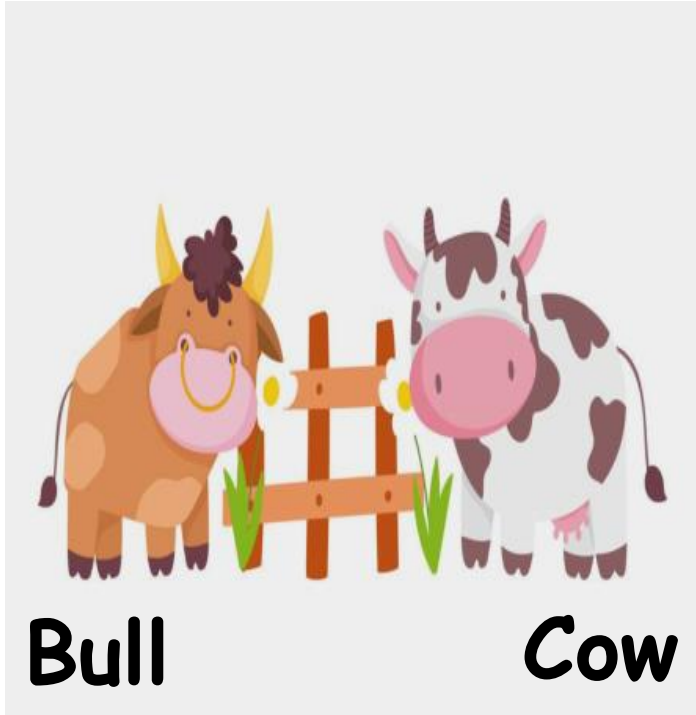

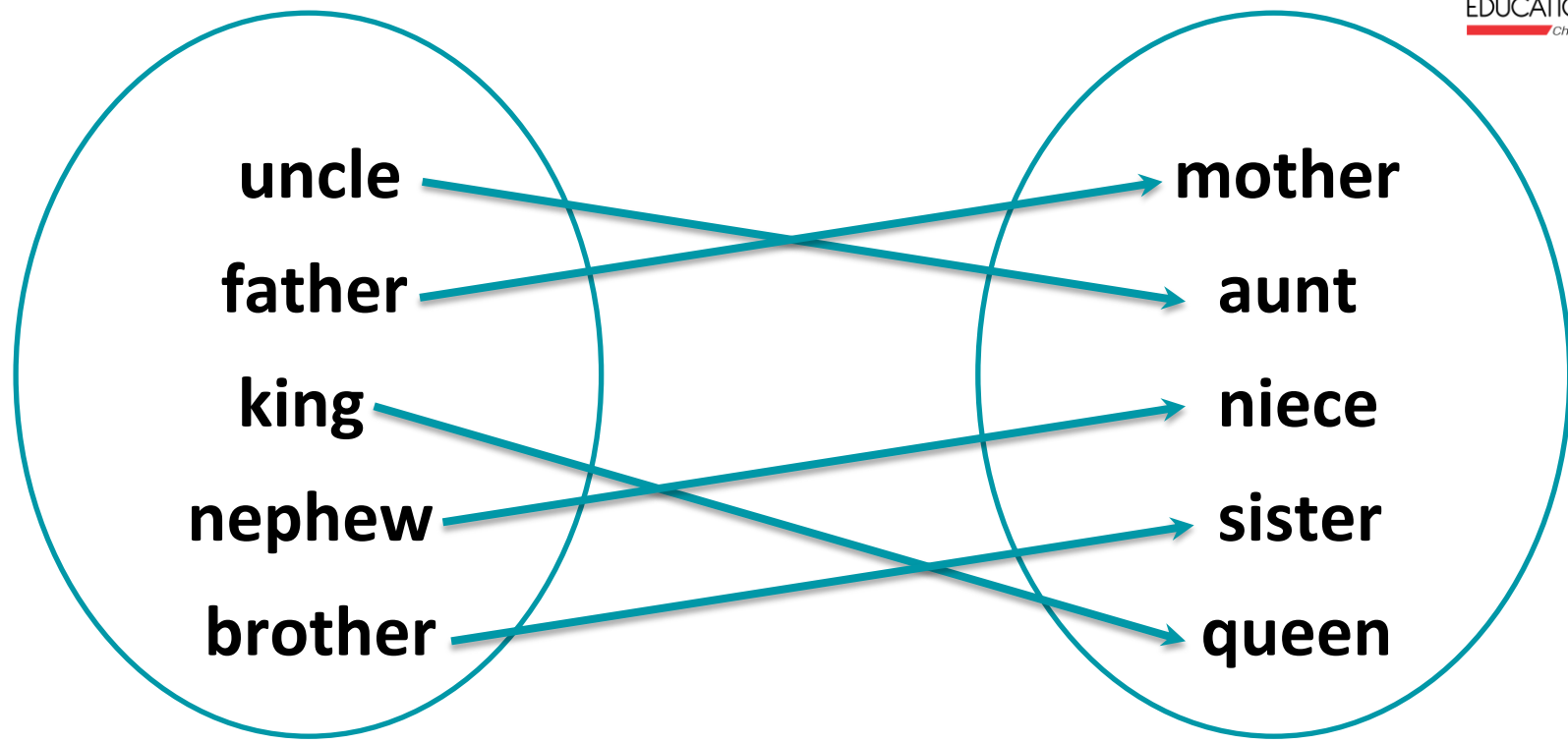
