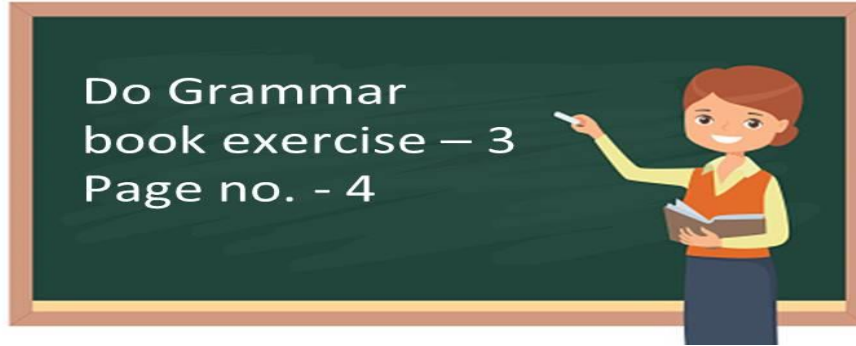

table

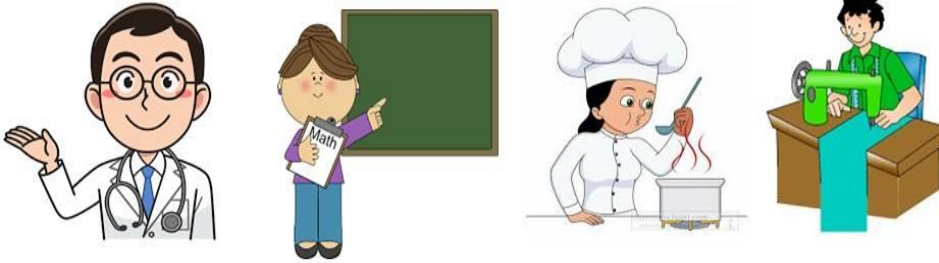

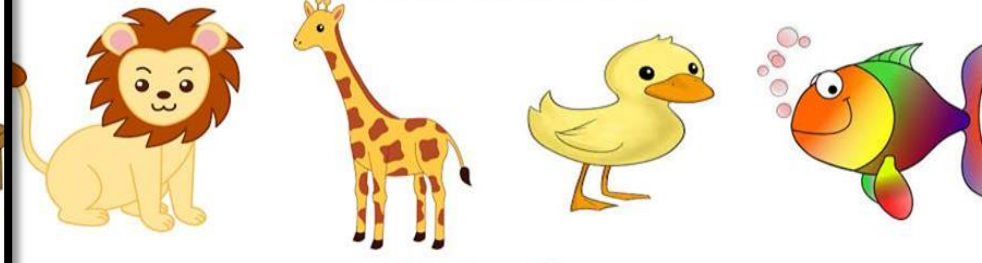

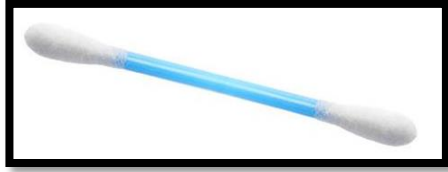
